Important – The Specialty on Saturday PM is PRE-ENTRY ONLY!!! Late entries for the Specialty will not be accepted in accordance with ASCA rules. You must print or type your entry clearly as we have to enter the information in a catalog.

Day of Show entries (excluding the Specialty Saturday PM) will be taken on Friday from 2:30pm to 3:15pm, on Saturday from 8:00am to 8:45am, on Sunday from 8:00am to 8:45am, and again on Sunday following the end of show #4, and closing 15 minutes prior to the start of the final show.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING ENTRIES & CLASS CHANGES –

- All entries must be fully completed and include entry fees at the time the entry is submitted in order to be accepted. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Pre-entries will be refunded only upon written request received prior to close of pre-entries. No other entry refunds will be granted.
- No class changes will be made once entries have closed. *This includes changes for errors made on entry form by owner/exhibitor.* It is the responsibility of the owner/exhibitor to have the correct dog information, class, sex, registration number, etc. on the entry when submitted. The dog call name and class will be listed on the back of each arm band. Please verify your class when picking up arm band(s).
- Move-ups are the only class changes that will be accepted for the Specialty (Saturday PM) after close of entries April 12, 2024. No other changes will be made on Specialty entries past the entry close date. All move-up requests must be made at least 15 minutes prior to the start of the Specialty show and must be completed on the ASCA change form provided at the show.
- All ASCA registered dogs over 6 months old must show proof of registration. No entry shall be accepted for a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or any person not in good standing with ASCA.
- All entry forms are available online at <https://www.asca.org/home/business-office/rules-forms/> Please type or print clearly. Entries not submitted on the current form (revision date 10/08/2020) cannot be accepted.
- Any check returned to our bank will invalidate all entries associated with that check. In addition, the person writing the check will be reported to ASCA, no exceptions. NCASC will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check and the total amount due must be paid, by cashier check or money order, within 5 business days of notification from NCASC. Anyone with a check returned must pay all future NCASC event fees by cash, money order, or cashier check.

New Champions (Altered & Intact) A new title medallion will be awarded to any dog or bitch who finishes their ASCA Conformation Championship at the NorCal ASC shows during this circuit.

SHOW / TRIAL RINGS, DAY SET UPS, & ELECTRICITY ACCESS

- The ring will be located on grass.
- Grooming is to be done at exhibitor set-ups and must be at least 20 feet away from the show ring.
- We recommend that you bring sun, wind, and rain protection.
- No day of show set-ups are allowed on the show unless an RV spot has been purchased.
- All day of show set-ups not tied to an RV spot must be outside the white fence surrounding the show ground area.
- Roping off or “pre-reserving” of day set-up spots will not be allowed prior to 1:30pm on Friday.
- No vehicles are allowed on the show lawn other than those at designated RV spots, per the grounds owner.
- All exhibitors can unload for day of show set-ups and then vehicles must be moved to the gravel parking lot adjacent to the show lawn.

IMPORTANT NOTE REGARDING ELECTRICITY HOOK-UPS – There is no electricity available unless an RV spot is reserved; however, generators are allowed at show set-ups but must be at least 20 feet from the show ring while in use. *If you are found to be plugged into any of the electrical outlets, unless tied to a paid RV spot, you will be charged the RV rental price by the show grounds. This is a facility rule and there are no exceptions. Please plan accordingly.*

GOLF CART RENTALS

A Limited number of golf carts are available to rent for \$60 per day. Please include your golf cart reservation with your entry submission.

OVERNIGHT RV/CAMPERS - NEW INFO FOR 2024

- All RV site reservations must be made through NorCal ASC and not Brookside. **Please email NorCalASCA@gmail.com no later than Monday, April 8th**, with your RV request and include the following: (1) Size of RV (length and how many slide outs); AMP requirement for RV; Location Preference – Show lawn (very limited and not guaranteed) or in the RV area (across the driveway with shaded spots). RV spots are available for Friday, Saturday, and Sunday nights.
- The RV spots are near the show area (not necessarily on the same lawn) for \$60 per night (includes water and 30 amp hook-ups).
- A limited number of 50 amp hook-ups are available at Brookside for \$60 per night and single additional charge of \$50 for the weekend. These 50 amp sites are not necessarily right near the show ring.
- Tent/van camping is \$30 per night. There is no camping on the shown lawn or in RV sites without an assigned/paid RV spot. Tent/van camping is without hook-ups and is located in the gravel parking lot adjacent to the show lawn. Camping is available for Friday and Saturday nights.
- All sites will be assigned with Brookside by Thursday morning prior to the show and will be clearly marked upon your arrival. Anyone found to be switching RV spot markers without authorization may be asked to leave the show grounds and forfeit their entries.
- If you need to be next to another camper, please be sure to include that in your email and we will do our best to accommodate.
- **All RV fees are collected by Brookside Equestrian Park at the show (cash, check, or credit card).**

ON-SITE RV TRAILER RENTALS

A Limited number of on-site RV rentals are available for \$135 per night (Friday, Saturday, and Sunday nights only), plus a 1 time pet fee of \$25. These sites by be reserved by sending an email to NorCalASCA@gmail.com **no later than March 1st**.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

Brookside Equestrian Park is a premier equestrian facility located at 11120 Bradley Ranch Rd., Elk Grove, CA 95624. It can be reached from Hwy 5 or Hwy 99. All NorCal ASC participants, dog owners, and attendees must be respectful of any equine events that may be taking place on the grounds. Also, please watch for children and/ or horses on the property, and be respectful of all facility employees and/or visitors.

SHOW SITE RULES /INFORMATION

By participating in these shows, you are agreeing to abide by the rules set forth by Brookside Equestrian Center. This is a fantastic facility for dog shows, so please help us ensure future events can be held at Brookside by complying with the following:

- All children attending the NorCal ASC show must be under the direct supervision of an adult at all times. If any children associated with the ASCA event are found to be unsupervised outside of the NorCal ASC shows grounds, it could result in excusal from the show site and no refund of entries will be given.
- No one associated with the NorCal ASC show is to enter any arena, barn or building (with the exception of restrooms) that is not part of the NorCal ASC show site (grass lawn on which the show is held).
- All posted signs and speed limits must be adhered to while on the facility premises. This includes are parking and no smoking signs.
- Absolutely no dogs will be allowed off leash for any reason at any time. This is a working equestrian facility and this rule will be strictly enforced.
- Brookside Equestrian Park, its owners or employees, reserve the right to remove anyone from the property for not following the facility rules (either posted on grounds or contained in this flyer). Any exhibitor or owner excused from the ground for any reason will not be entitled to a refund of any entries or RV fees.
- Per the facility owner, all vehicles, other than those in a designated RV spot, must be parked in the gravel lot adjacent to the show lawn. Please do not park on the shown lawn or along the outside of white fence line surrounding the shown lawn.
