NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The Trial Secretary is not responsible for emails not received. If you have not received a response to an email after 24 hours, please call the Trial Secretary by telephone.

This trial will be held under the current Rules and Regulations of ASCA. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial including, but not limited to, the following rules regarding entry:

- No entries shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA agility program, a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs, or a member not in good standing with ASCA. A list of such dogs will be supplied by the ASCA Business Office, along with the sanctioning paperwork.
- The Trial Committee has the right to refuse any entry on the basis expressly provided through ASCA rules and regulations or guidelines established by the ASCA Board of Directors.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25 service charge for each returned check.
- Pre-Entry Move-Ups will be accepted until Monday, April 29, 2024 at 6 PM EST.
- Day-to-Day Move-Ups close at the end of each trial day.
- All decisions made by the judge(s) are final.
- There shall be no refunds or entries withdrawn after the pre-entry closing date or in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge or club, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. In addition, no entry fees will be refunded if the trials cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the club.
- Partial refund will be given for bitches that come in season after the Pre-entry closing date. A veterinarian's certificate must be given to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging. Refund will be equal to entry fees for bitch less \$5 per day entered.
- It's recommended to bring your own chairs and water for your dogs.
- There will be no equipment familiarization at this trial.
- All exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or child(ren). Any exhibitor whose dog(s) or child (ren) engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. No refund of fees will be made.
- Any handler, owner, or spectator using excessive corrections or abuse towards a dog or exhibiting poor sportsmanship while at the show site will be asked to leave for the duration of the show weekend.
- All dogs must be kept on lead, in X-pens or crates when not competing in the ring. No dogs may be tied to chairs, crates, fences, cars, trees, etc. Dogs not entered in the trial(s) will be allowed on the trial site, provided that they remain in the control of their owner/handler. Dogs not entered in the trial(s) that prove to be disruptive will be required to leave the grounds.
- No puppies under the age of 8 weeks allowed at the show site.
- Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs. Exhibitors who do not clean up after their dogs at the trial site or hotels will be excused from the trial. No refunds if excused.
- Crossroads Australian Shepherd Club, their Board, Members, Trial Staff and Flying Paws Agility as such will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through disappearance, loss, theft, communicable disease, parasites, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Electronic timers will be used at these trials

Toys will be allowed in the ring for training purposes

- Any tie breaker will be determined by fastest total YPS and Gamble points

HEIGHT CARDS - CHECK IN OPTIONS

All dogs except those jumping 20+", Vets jumping 16+, ACE Standard jumping 16+, and ACE Senior Dog jumping 12+ must show an ASCA, AKC or NADAC Height Card or be measured at Trial,

Self check-in if a copy of dog's Height Card is sent with entry

EQUIPMENT

All obstacles used will be chosen from those described in the current official ASCA rules: Slatted dog walk, Slatted A-frame (height 5'-6"), teeter-totter, open tunnel, 24" weave poles, break-away tire jump, and winged and non-winged jumps. All Contacts are rubber.

DIRECTIONS

Northbound I-69 Exit: Take Exit 125 into the traffic circle. Take the third exit on the traffic circle to cross over I-69. Keep straight through the second traffic circle to Sample Road.

Southbound I-69 Exit: Take Exit 125 into the traffic circle. Take the first exit on the traffic circle to Sample Road.

Sample Road: Follow Sample Road for approximately two miles. Please note Sample Road is curvy and families do walk on it & bike on it. Drive carefully. Close to the two miles mark, you will pass an "End Construction" sign, which marks the change from Sample Road to North Bottom Road for a mile-and-a-half. Your destination will be a big barn on the left. There will be a Flying Paws Agility Club Sign at the entrance to the driveway.

GPS NOTES: If you are following the GPS, it will instruct you to turn into a residential driveway. We will have a sign up that says Flying Paws Agility Club- please turn on the driveway at the sign! Once you turn onto the driveway, you should be approaching a large barn, NOT a house!
