500 Club: Agility

Points will be counted for a one year period; from June 1st to May 31st. Junior Program ownership requirements will be followed. Juniors may only collect points for one dog per show if trialing multiple dogs. The dog with the highest point value per day will be used for calculation.

You must include the following items for consideration:

- Completed application form, signed by the applicant and a parent or guardian.
- Agility Individual Results from each trial.
- HIT overall and HITJR must be verified and signed for by the Trial Secretary at the end of each trial. The award is not mandatory at trials and therefore must be verified. It is the Juniors responsibility to ensure they check in with the trial secretary.

The application and required documentation must be received by the Junior Committee no later than July 30 following the end of the competition year.

Each faulted (.01 to 5 faults) qualifying run in Regular Agility must be given one-half the value of the equivalent level points: Elite 3.5, Open 3, Novice 2.5
